Setting arrangements

Students are taught in tutor groups of mixed ability in Years 7 and 8. Students apply to participate in a twilight class in Year 9, preparing them for the GCSE course in Year 10 and 11. Students do well at GCSE and in 2017, 100% achieved A-C grades.

In Year 12 and 13 students are taught together for most of their lessons as part of BTEC Dance course which is a 2 year course, equivalent to 1 A Level. In 2017, all of our students achieved Distinction Stars!
