## YATELEYS YOUTH CLUB

Yateley's Youth Club is funded by Yateley Town Council and has been actively running for nine years. It is aimed at helping Year 6 students with the transition into Yateley School and provides an ongoing youth club for the students.

The youth club is held in the Drama Block (by the library) of Yateley School and provides an area for students to relax and listen to music. We also use other areas of the school for activities which enables the students to familiarise themselves with the school premises and meet students from other schools and make new friends.
