FAQs

 - Register in your normal lesson shown on your timetable
 - Check with your teacher that you are allowed to go to a different subject for that period
 - If agreed you then go to the department that has requested you
 - You <u>must</u> then remain in department until the end of the period, do not return back to your normal lesson.
