YEAR 7 & 11 CAN USE THE APP FROM MONDAY.

YEARS 8,9 & 10 WILL FOLLOW LATER IN THE WEEK.

Over the next week we will be e mailing all students with a letter explaining how to download a fantastic new app that we will be using to Pre order there lunch with on a daily basis. Please get your child to download the app if they wish to order lunch as the Goggle form will not be running once all students have the app registration.



The app has many fantastic features

So, what can you do in the app?

Check your balance

That's right! No longer do you need to queue at a device in the school to check whether you have enough funds remaining to order that meal you've been thinking about; you can now check your balance at home or on the school bus, at any time of day.

Order your food in advance

Obviously, the most important part of a pre-order is the ability to order your food in advance, and you can do precisely that. Choose when you're ordering for, where you want to collect your food from, and then choose from our tasty menus and we'll take care of the rest.

View your upcoming meal selections

If you've placed multiple pre-orders, it's easy to check what you've ordered from within the app. We'll show you all your meal choices along with your unique order number, so that when it's time to collect your food all you need to do is turn up and show your order number.

What if I need help with the app?

We're hoping that the app is really easy to use, but don't worry, if you do run into any problems, you can always visit <u>https://connect.crbcunninghams.co.uk/help</u> to view a range of articles that should get you up and running in no time.

As this is new to the school, we will be phasing it in over the next week so please don't worry if your child does not get the link code at the start of the week.

THE APP WILL BE REPLACING THE GOOGLE FORM SO THIS WILL BE CLOSED ONCE ALL STUDENTS HAVE RECEIVED THE LETTER ON HOW TO USE THE APP.

WE WILL BE RUNNING BOTH THE GOOGLE FORM AND THE APP AT THE START BUT WE WOULD LIKE YOU TO USE THE APP AS SOON AS YOU HAVE THE LINK CODE.
















IF YOU ORDER FROM THE APP AND GOOGLE FORM, I AM AFRAID YOU WILL BE CHARGED FOR BOTH AS WE CANNOT CHECK IF WE HAVE DOUBLE ORDERS AND THE STUDENT WILL GET TWO LUNCHES.

The app will also not let the student go into a debit balance of more than £5 so if the account goes into arrears, it will be to a maximum of £5.

Those students who get a Free School Meal allowance this will also show on the app.
