# GCSE WEEKAHEAD

#### YOUR GUIDE TO EXAM SUCCESS AT YATELEY SCHOOL

#### What is GCSE Week Ahead?

The "GCSE Week Ahead" document is a valuable tool to help students effectively navigate the busy period of their GCSE examinations.

Designed as a comprehensive planner, it includes crucial information on upcoming exams, revision classes, study boosters, after-school sessions, study mornings, study leave and key dates.

Here's how students can make the most out of this resource:

#### How to use GCSE Week Ahead:

#1 Routine: Each week, students should start by reviewing the "GCSE Week Ahead" document. It provides a schedule for the upcoming days, including specific dates and AM/PM for each exam. This overview allows you to prioritise their study time according to the proximity of each exam. Remember though: nothing is ever a substitute for your own exam timetable and it is possible that there are slight errors/omissions as this is a complex document to put together!

**#2 Revision Classes:** The document details when and where revision classes are held. These sessions are crucial for clarifying doubts, understanding complex topics, and reinforcing knowledge. Students should attend these classes as per the schedule to ensure they are well-prepared for their exams. They are listed as either **OPTIONAL** or **COMPULSORY**.

#3 Study Boosters and After-School Sessions: Highlighted sessions in the document indicate additional study opportunities outside normal school hours. These include after-school sessions and study mornings designed to give students extra time and support in a structured environment. Making regular use of these sessions can significantly enhance a student's readiness for their exams but there is no expectation that students attend optional sessions.

**#4 Preparation and Planning:** "GCSE Week Ahead" serves as a planning tool. Students should use it to allocate specific times for self-study and revision at home, balancing their schedule to avoid burnout. Regular breaks and varied subjects during revision times can help maintain focus and interest.

**#5** Stay Informed and Ask for Help: If there are **changes** to the schedule or additional sessions added, you will be updated accordingly via email. Please check this regularly!

By using the "GCSE Week Ahead" document as a guide, students can organise their revision more effectively, stay informed about upcoming sessions, and approach their GCSE exams with confidence. Good luck everyone!
