

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

A number of departments ask parents to make a financial contribution towards the cost of materials used throughout Key Stage 3 (these do not necessarily apply to students on free school meals now or in the last six years). The details are outlined below:

KS3 Art Sketchbooks - in order that all students have a quality sketchbook for class work and homework we put in a bulk order at the start of each year. The books are solid, hard backed and have good quality paper. They should last until Year 9 and the discounted price is £2.50 each.

KS3 Food and Nutrition - as part of your son/daughter's Food Technology course during Years 7, 8 and 9 (Key Stage 3), a range of equipment, materials and some taster ingredients will be provided to give the pupils a varied and interesting practical based curriculum. In order to allow the greatest opportunity for the students, we ask you for a one-off contribution of £15 to cover the three years.

KS3 Design and Technology - Design and Technology is essentially a practical subject and all students will design and make products which are theirs on completion. Materials are bought in bulk by the department at very competitive prices, but in order to enable us to provide students with a good choice of material for their chosen design we ask for a one-off contribution of £15 to cover the three years of Key Stage 3.
