Endeavour and determination has paid off for Yateley School students who are celebrating excellent GCSE results. There has been further pressure on results this year, with an effort to pin national results back to pre-pandemic grade boundaries, and with no accommodation made around pandemic disruption. There has, of course been significant disruption to their secondary school careers and we applaud our Year 11 students who through sheer hard work, tenacity and admirable ambition, have been rewarded with results that reflect their hard work and commitment throughout their courses. Importantly, these are door opening qualifications that pave the way for success and opportunity in the future, be that in our Sixth Form or elsewhere. We wish all our students well and congratulate them on their achievement.



With strong results across the cohort, top scoring student Elliott Casselton (pictured) achieved eight grade 9s and a Grade A in Additional Maths. He is joined by Ella Arnold who gained 5 Grade 9s and 5 Grade 8s. Other high performers, Beth Nwachukwu, Kai Mellor, Matthew Jarratt-Walker and Max Alexander achieved 47 of the top grades between them; 15 of them at Grade 9!

At subject level, there were excellent performances from Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Dance, Drama, German, Food Technology, PE, all of whom had a GCSE pass rate of at least 90% at Grade 4 or above.
